Re: EMERGENCY REGULATION OF THE LITTLETON BOARD OF HEALTH

---

In response to increased cases of COVID-19 infection in the Town of Littleton and Middlesex County, the Littleton Board of Health has enacted an emergency regulation with the goal of providing another mitigation measure to reduce the spread of COVID-19. The regulation requires all persons, regardless of vaccination status, aged 2 years or older to wear face coverings, that cover the nose and mouth, in all indoor public spaces, social clubs, municipal buildings, houses of worship, or private spaces open to the public.

This regulation shall become effective at 12:01am on Tuesday, September 7, 2021.

The Board of Health is providing this notice and copy of the regulation for your review, ahead of the effective date, to facilitate a smooth enactment and to answer any questions you may have regarding the regulation. If you should have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact our office.

We appreciate your cooperation with the various COVID-19 related protocols and standards throughout the pandemic; this emergency regulation has been enacted to address the current increase in cases and we again ask for your cooperation to protect the residents of Littleton.
